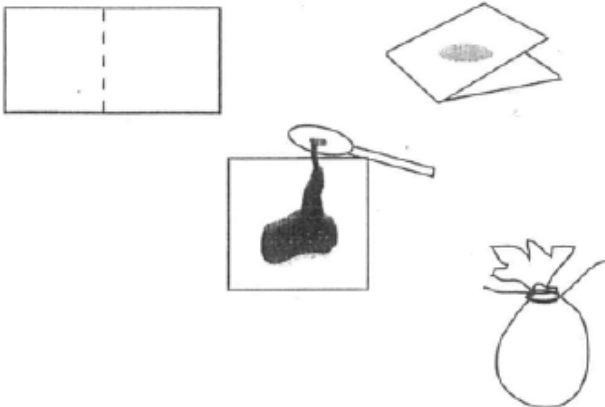
What to Bring:

Indian Costume for Friday Night, Flashlight, Camera/Film, Towels, Toiletries, Extra Socks & Shoes, Sleeping Bags/Single Sheets/Blanket, Pillows, Indian Cabin Decorations, Trash Bags, Firewood Torch Supplies, Camp Chairs, Flour Balls, Boots, Raingear, Snacks & Drinks, Vests, and Bug Spray

FLOUR BALL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using two squares of toilet tissue, fold to size of one.
2. Place one tablespoon of flour in the center of the square
3. Lift four corners and tie a string or thread around the four corners to form a ball

Note: Suggest nine balls for each Princess and three for each Guide (Big Brave).



TORCH INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take a pole 3' to 4' long.
2. Wrap one end with a rag.
3. Tie the rag onto the pole securely by wrapping it around the pole several times.
4. Fuel for the torch will be provided at the Campout.
