

Kettering Adventure Guides and Princesses Dottie Cromer Hall of Fame

Organization Bylaws

Purpose: This award is presented by the South YMCA in conjunction with the Dottie Cromer Hall of Fame Selection Committee to recognize individuals, families and corporations who, over a period of time, have made inordinate or unselfish contributions to the betterment of the Kettering Adventure Guide and Princess Programs.

Hall of Fame Selection Committee: The Committee shall be comprised of:

- ◆ The Executive Director of the South YMCA,
- ◆ Program Director of the South YMCA,
- ◆ Current Chiefs of the Kettering Adventure Guide & Princess Programs,
- ◆ Immediate Past Chiefs of the Kettering Adventure Guide & Princesses Programs
- ◆ One past Officer elected by the Guide Longhouse and
- ◆ One past Officer elected by the Princess Longhouse.

If an appointed or elected Committee member is unable to serve or carry out his duties, the applicable Longhouse shall elect a replacement Committee member. Such replacement Committee member must be an active or past Officer.

Hall of Fame Selection Committee Duties: This Committee will manage the Hall of Fame Selection process, organizing & conducting meetings; solicit nominations, review of completed nominations, elections and induction. The Chief of the Guides will be responsible for organizing the initial committee each year, at which time a Selection Committee Chairman will be elected. The Chairman will schedule and lead the remaining Committee meetings for that year. If the Chairman is unable to serve or carry out his duties, the Committee shall elect a new Chairman to complete the term.

Eligibility: Any individual, family or corporation, who over a period of time has made an inordinate or unselfish contribution to the Guide and Princess Programs, is eligible for induction into the Dottie Cromer Hall of Fame. Normally, there will be two or less inductees elected by the Selection Committee per calendar year. No Nation Chief will be eligible sooner than two years after their service as Nation Chief.

Election: Nominations shall be made by completing a nomination form obtained from the South YMCA and submitting it to the Program Director of the South YMCA or the Selection Committee Chairman. All nominations must be submitted by March 31st to be considered for induction in that year. The Selection Committee Chairman shall oversee the voting on eligible nominated inductees at a scheduled Committee meeting. The election shall be by secret ballot. All Committee members are eligible to vote. A two-thirds (2/3rds) majority of the votes cast is required for induction.

Hall of Fame Members: Hall of Fame members are all past inductees into the Dottie Cromer Hall of Fame. At their request, Hall of Fame members will receive the monthly mailings of the Guide and Princess Programs. Hall of Fame members who wish to remain apprised of new nominations received, should contact the South YMCA Program Director to receive copies of the completed nomination forms.

Hall of Fame Member Elections: Each year Hall of Fame Members may nominate candidates and elect one member to be inducted whose contributions to the programs may have been missed by past Selection Committees. All Hall of Fame Members shall be eligible to vote for these candidates. A two-thirds (2/3's) majority of the votes cast is required for induction. The South YMCA Program Director, via secret ballot, will conduct this voting.

Induction: If possible, the induction of the newly elected member(s) of the Dottie Cromer Hall of Fame will take place at the Saturday night campfire of either the Guides or Princess Spring campout.

Amendments: Amendments to these guidelines shall require a two-thirds (2/3's) majority of all the Selection Committee Members.
