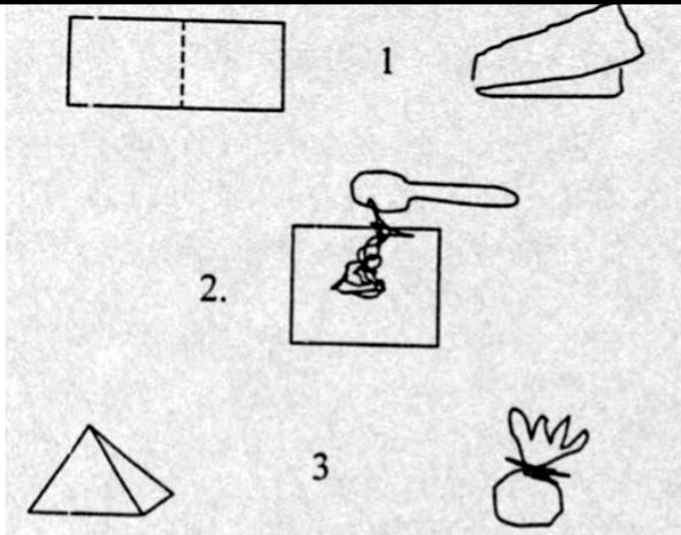

### Flour Ball Instructions:

1. Using two squares of toilet paper, fold to the size of one.
2. Place (1) tablespoon of flour in the center of the square.
3. Lift all four corners and tie a thread or string around the four corners to form a ball.

Note: Suggest nine (9) balls for each Guide and three (3) for each Big Guide

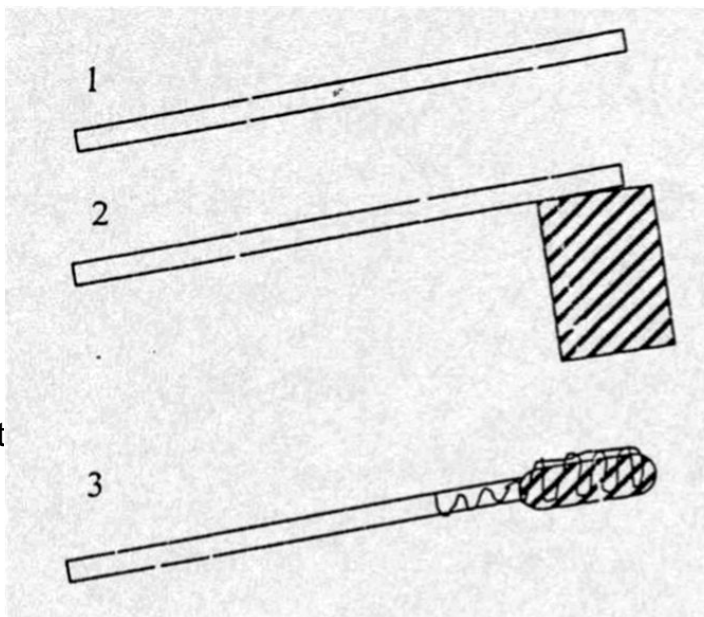


### What to Bring:

### Torch Making

1. Take a pole 3' to 4' long
2. Wrap one end tightly with a rag.
3. Tie the rag on to the pole securely with a wire (coat hangers work good) wrapping it around several times.
4. Fuel for the torch will be provided at the campout
